

## NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING

### 2023 CDBG COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS: ALLOCATION GRANT

The City of Chillicothe applied to the Ohio Department of Development/Office of Community Development for funding under the 2023 CDBG Community Development Allocation Program, including competitive set-aside of Critical Infrastructure. The City is eligible for \$150,000 under the Allocation Program.

On May 11, 2023, the City conducted the first public hearing to inform citizens about this grant program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements. Based on both citizen input and local officials' assessment of the City's needs, the City is proposing to undertake the following activities for the Allocation Program:

- \$63,500 will be used for the Pump House Center for the Arts improvements (this project qualifies under the National Objective: Area Benefit to Low-to-Moderate Income Persons)
- \$51,500 will be used for construction of a Pump Track in Yoctangee Park (this project qualifies under the National Objective: Area Benefit to Low-to-Moderate Income Persons)
- \$5,000 will be used toward Planning activity for the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. (National Objective: Area Benefit to Low-to-Moderate Income Persons)
- \$30,000 will be used for administration and implementation of the projects, as well as the required Fair Housing program.

**The second public hearing will be held on June 8, at 2:00 p.m., in the Chillicothe Transit Conference Room, 575 East 7th Street, Chillicothe to give citizens the opportunity to review and comment on The City of Chillicothe's proposed activities.**
