NATURE OF WORK:

- *This is supervisory work in the operation and maintenance of the Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- *Responsibility in this classification is for scheduling and supervising the work of subordinate plant personnel.
- *Responsible for coordinating the maintenance and laboratory testing that pertains to and/or affects the wastewater plant operation and takes part in the work when necessary.
- *Being in responsible charge in the absence of the Wastewater Supervisor.
- *Work is performed with considerable independence, but a departmental superior gives instructions for special assignments and reviews the work for efficiency and maintenance of proper standards.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE/TRAINING:

- High school diploma or G.E.D. equivalency.
- Valid Ohio driver's license and insurability under the City's fleet coverage as required.
- Class III OEPA Wastewater Operator's Certification.
- Five years' experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment plant.
- Must pass a physical examination as well as a drug and alcohol test by a doctor and medical laboratory designated by and paid for by the City of Chillicothe.
