**Re:** Mask Requirements Continue

---

Although the Ohio Health Orders pertaining to masks will be lifted June 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) is requiring the continued use of face masks for all transportation networks that are federally funded, including Chillicothe Transit System, through September 13, 2021.

Please note:

- Masks will continue to be required on all buses and any transit property, including the transit hub. If an individual is unable to wear a mask due to a disability or medical condition, that individual can request for reasonable modification under the Americans with Disabilities Act and, if eligible, will be transported with a separate vehicle.
- The 10-person limited capacity on the bus will be lifted June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Individuals showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 are asked not to ride. If a rider needs transportation for testing, the individual can contact dispatch to schedule an individual ride with additional safety protocol in place.
