

# Ride with Chillicothe Transit System's RossGo Program

Do you have Medicaid? You may qualify to be transported to and from your Medicaid-billable appointment at no cost to you.



## What is RossGo?

RossGo is a program which operates under Chillicothe Transit System that provides transportation to and from Medicaid-billable appointments such as primary care visits, eye doctors, and substance use disorder treatment.

## How does it work?

Chillicothe Transit System subcontracts with six transportation providers. These providers will pick you up at your residence, take you to your appointment, and return you home.

## Who can ride?

RossGo is for Medicaid-eligible residents of Ross, Hocking, and Vinton Counties.

## Where can I be transported to?

The service area includes the counties of – Athens, Fairfield, Fayette, Franklin, Gallia, Highland, Hocking, Jackson, Licking, Meigs, Perry, Pickaway, Pike, Scioto, Ross, and Vinton.

## Are there requirements/restrictions?

To qualify for RossGo you must have Medicaid and be transported to a Medicaid billable appointment. Once you are registered, you must provide a three-business day notice before your upcoming appointment.

## How do I sign up?

To take advantage of the RossGo program simply call CTS at 740-773-1569 ext.106 and answer a few short questions. Once your eligibility is confirmed through SCOJFS you can start being transported!
